מטעמי פרשה - פרשת שמות Parsha Delight Question

Hashem told Moshe Rabbeinu at the סנה, the burning bush, של רגליך געליך מעל רגליך, remove your shoes from your feet. Why was it necessary to add "from your feet", it is not obvious that when one removes his shoes it would be from off his feet?

Last Week's Question:

היהי ימי יעקב שבע שנים וארבעים ומאת שנה. And the days of Yaakov were seven years, and forty, and one hundred years (47:28). Regarding Sara Imeinu, it states (23:1), מאה שנה ועשרים שנה ושבע שנים One hundred years, and twenty years, and seven years. Why is the term "years" stated three times in the context of Sara Imeinu, and with regard to Yaakov Avinu it is stated only twice? Answers Received:

- Yaakov Avinu's years were diminished by 30 because of the way he spoke to Pharoh. To indicate this, the term שנה is missing from the "tens"; "forty", to indicate it was diminished by "tens", that is thirty years. (Had his life been diminished by less than ten years, than the term שנה would have been missing from the "ones" or שבע seven.)
- In the context of Sarah Imeinu, the term שנת attached to עשרים is to indicate that she was יבת בי כבת זי ליופי, that she was of great beauty. Obviously, this is irrelevant to Yaakov Avinu. Hence, the missing term שנה.
- Yaakov Avinu indeed has a challenging life, as the Gemorah says that the Possuk שבע יפול צדיק וקם, seven calamities befall the Tzaddik and he arises, refers to Yaakov Avinu. To indicate that, the term שנה is lacking.
