Erev Shabbos/Kabalas Shabbos

It is recommended that melacha not be performed on the West Side after the latest minyan recites Mizmor Shir, even when Mizmor Shir is recited well before shkiah. Mizmor Shir is recited approximately 30-35 minutes after the start of Mincha. In these weeks it seems that the latest minyan is in the Shul. You can easily calculate the latest recommended time to perform Melacha by looking at the time for Mincha above an d adding 30-35 minutes. This concern relates to candle lighting as well. So, as an example, when Mincha starts at 6:15, it is ideal that melacha and candlelighting take place before 6:45. In a circumstance that that is not possible, candles should still be lit 18 minutes before shkiah, which time is also indicated above.
