Shovavim Shiurim for Men and for Women



פרשת בשלח - מטעמי פרשה - Parsha Delight Question

In the context of destroying Amalek, the possuk (17:14) states, כי ימחה את זכר עמלק "מתחת השמים", that I will erase the memory of Amalek "from under the heavens". However, in the context of destruction to be brought through the מבול, the possuk (Berashis 6:7) states, "אמחה את האדם אשר בראתי מעל על פני האדמה", I will erase mankind that I have created, "from upon the face of the earth". Why the inconsistency? Why not both "from under the heavens" or both "from upon the face of the earth"?
