מטעמי זרע אברהם פרשת בשלח

Last Week's Question:

In the context of destroying Amalek, the possuk (17:14) states, כי מוח אמה, את זכר עמלק "מתחת השמים" that I will erase the memory of Amalek "from under the heavens". However, in the context of destruction to be brought through the מבול, the possuk (Berashis 6:7) states, אמחה את האדם אשר בראתי "מעל על פני האדמה", I will erase mankind that I have created, "from upon the face of the earth". Why the inconsistency? Why not both "from under the heavens" or both "from upon the face of the earth"?

Answers Received:

The sin of the דור המבול related to physicality - ארציות, and therefore they were destroyed מעל פני האדמה, while the sin of עמלק is spiritual - שמימיות, and therefore they are to be destroyed מתחת השמים.

The unique term מעל פני האדמה, is to indicate that that which was not earth dwelling, such as fish and the people in the תיבה, was not destroyed.

The unique term מתחת השמים, is to indicate that the heavenly force of Amalek is already destroyed. What is left is only the residual force of עמלק left in this world. Therefore מוח אמה that which is מתחת השמים, for in שמים itself, there is no עמלק. That is why the possuk refers to this as זכר עמלק, only a residue of Amalek.
