

מטעמי זרע אברהם פרשת יתרו

Last Week's Question:

The possuk (18:21) describes all the various characteristics that the שרים of כלל ישראל should have - אנשי חיל, יראי אלקים, אנשי אמת, שנאי בצע. And the possuk continues that from these should be chosen שרי אלפים, שרי מאות, שרי חמשים, שרי עשרות. Now, if they all had these qualities, who got to be a chosheve שר אלף, and who had to settle to just be a שר עשר? Answers Received:

That's the reason why they has to be אנשי אמת, because an איש אמת, knows who is. Each one recognized what he position is without being

There is a powerful lesson here. Whether in a position to guide a group of 10 or to guide a group of 1000, each position requires specialized skills and integrity. Indeed, all the characteristics listed are necessary equally to fill any one of the four positions required.

מטעמי פרשה פרשת משפטים Parsha Delight Ouestion

The possuk (23:7) states, מדבר שקר תרחק, Distance yourself from a falsehood. The terminology seems somewhat soft. Shouldn't the mitzvah be more emphatic? "Sheker is Assur!" "Eradicate Sheker!" At least let it be termed as a לא תעשה, a negative commandment: לא תקרבו לדבר שקר. Why is it a מצות עשה?
