- Worksheets that have three or more words of a possuk and were used.
- Worksheets which have answers on them, and are written with enough detail to the extent that if one were to read them with the answers one would understand the concept contained therein.
- A paper with a name of Hashem. If the paper as a whole is not shaimos, the name of Hashem may be torn out and put in shaimos alone.

Items that may be wrapped up and thrown away:

- Photocopies of seforim that were not used.
- A publication which includes divrei Torah, but whose main function is not for learning (e.g. a Jewish newspaper, Hillel Highlights, this week's edition of the CZA newsletter.) This is true even when it includes a quote of a possuk. This does not include a special pull-out section of the newspaper of divrei Torah, which is to be treated as shaimos.

מטעמי פרשה פרשת כי תשא Parsha Delight Question

Rashi on the possuk (34:1), מכל לך שני לחות אבנים, carve for yourself two stone Tablets, expalins that Moshe Rabbeinu was charged with the responsibilty of carving the new luchos, because he was as an attendant to a bride that was keeping bad company, and was therefore suspected of infidelity, for which reason the attendant tore up the Kesubah of the bride. Once it was realized that the infidelity was committed only by the bad company, and not the bride, therefore the groom demanded the attendant to supply the materials for a new Kesubah. In the same vein, now that it was realized that only the Eirav Rav committed the sin of the Eigel, now Moshe, as the attendant who broke the luchos/Kesubah, must now supply the materials for new luchos for the "groom" - Hashem, to give to the "bride" - Klal Yisroel. Does this mean that the breaking of the Luchos was a mistake on Moshe Rabbeinu's part, as much as it was a mistake of the attendant to suspect the bride of infidelity?
