Program

Project Avreichim Members will be an intrinsic part of the West Side Zera Avraham community. While training for their professions, they will participate in the Yeshiva Toras Chaim sederim and as well as in the davening at the Zera Avraham Shul.

1. Full Morning Seder at Yeshiva Toras Chaim

The Avreichim will add to the critical mass of the Yeshiva, by bringing their knowledge, skills and abilities to join the Yeshiva Chabura. They will:

- Provide energetic engagement with bochorim of the Mesivta and Bais HaMedrash and serve as role models
- Deliver chaburos to bochorim, as well as to the other Avreichim

2. Enrollment in coursework or vocational training

Denver has a large variety of both higher education and vocational schools, many of which are only a few miles from Zera Abraham and Yeshiva Toras Chaim.

- Participants will enroll in afternoon or evening vocational programs
- Coursework will lead to immediate gainful employment after two years

3. Additional Seder

Participants will study for an additional 1-1/2 hours, afternoon or evening, subject and location at the discretion of Rabbi Aaron Kagan and Rabbi Tzvi Steinberg

4. Enhancing Community Davening

Avreichim will daven all tefilos at Zera Avraham, adding to the ranks of Bnei Torah in each minyan and enhancing the already special ruach of our Makom Tefilah.

5. Women's Community Involvement

Wives of Avreichim will be active in creating programs for women for social interaction and engagement with the greater community, including in-home venues as well as outings, with consideration to parents of young children.

Project Avreichim will provide a framework within which qualified candidates can move to West Denver, contribute to the community, and learn a trade within a spiritually wholesome and healthy environment.

Yeshiva Toras Chaim and Congregation Zera Avraham are spearheading Project Avreichim in conjunction with job search and housing programs to fulfill the vision of the West Side thriving as a fiscally sound community.
