It is recommended that melacha not be performed on the West Side after the latest minyan recites Mizmor Shir, even when Mizmor Shir is recited well before shkiah. Mizmor Shir is recited approximately 30-35 minutes after the start of Mincha. In these weeks it seems that the latest minyan is in the Shul. You can easily calculate the latest recommended time to perform Melacha by looking at the time for Mincha above and adding 30-35 minutes. This concern relates to candle lighting as well. So, as an example, when Mincha starts at 6:15, it is ideal that melacha and candlelighting take place before 6:45. In a circumstance that that is not possible, candles should still be lit 18 minutes before shkiah, which time is also indicated above.

On the possuk (22:28) כי היכתני זה שלש רגלים, when the donkey expresses, why did you strike me these three "regalim"- three times, Rashi brings that the donkey was hinting to בלעם the futility of attempting to destroy כלל ישראל who celebrate the שלש רגלים, the three ימים טובים. Why does the celebration of the שלש רגלים specifically relate to the impossibility of destroying כלל ישראל?

מטעמי פרשה פרשת חקת

Last week's Question:

In the possuk (20:8) Hashem commands Moshe Rabbeinu for the purpose of drawing water from the rock, קח את המטה, take the staff. In possuk (20:9) it states ויקח משה את המטה מלפני הי, and Moshe took the staff from before Hashem. Where exactly had the staff been? And for what purpose does the possuk tell us that the staff was taken from there?

Answers Received:

The מטה that Moshe Rabbeinu took was not his own, rather the מטה of Aharon that was used to assert his position as כהן גדול and counter the claims of קרח. Moshe Rabbeinu had been instructed to place that staff מלפני הי as an everlasting sign of the proof against קרח. Now, כלל ישראל again was questioning the authority of and therefore the מטה of אהרן needed to be displayed in public.

In line with the idea that this was the מטה of אהרן, it could be said that it was appropriate to display the staff which sprouted שקדים as from nothing, in order to facilitate the $\ensuremath{\text{co}}$ of the water coming from the rock, as if from nothing.
